Introduction

Thank you for your interest in the College Scholar program presented by Women In Defense Michigan Chapter (WID-MI). WID, A National Security Organization, is a non-profit professional networking and development organization for women and men across Michigan who contribute to national security and defense. Formed in 2007, the Michigan Chapter seeks to strengthen and influence the defense industry by inspiring women, cultivating leadership, and growing professional relationships.

Scholarship History

WID-MI established the College Scholar program in 2009 to encourage women to pursue careers related to the national security and defense interests of the United States, and to provide development opportunities to women already working in these fields

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the College Scholar program, applicants must demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career related to national security or defense, or already be working in these fields. Candidates are eligible to receive a college scholarship twice, and must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be a woman
- Be a resident of Michigan
- Be currently enrolled at an **accredited Michigan university or college**, either full-time or part-time
- Be a graduate or an undergraduate who has attained at least junior level status (60 credits)
- Have a minimum grade point average of **3.0**
- Demonstrate educational expenses

Application Instructions

Applications must be completed in full and only items requested in the checklist below should be sent. Please do not include extra items such as copies of awards, certificates, photographs or resumes. Only students meeting the above listed eligibility criteria will be considered with no exceptions. Answer all applicable questions as completely as possible and follow any additional instructions listed for each section as required.



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Application Checklist

The full application package must be received by **July 31, 2025** and must include: **Items you submit:**

- Completed application
- Proof of U.S. citizenship (passport or birth certificate, redacted)
- Attached narrative responses

Items others submit directly to WID on your behalf:

- Official transcripts - direct from your school(s), unofficial may be sent while waiting for official ones
- Two letters of recommendation - direct from individuals, one from a faculty/university member

For items submitted by the applicant:

All required materials should be submitted together in one email to the following email address: scholarships@wid-mi.org. You will receive a confirmation via email when your application is received.

For recommendation letters:

Letters should be signed and submitted directly by the author to the following email address: scholarships@wid-mi.org.

For official transcripts:

Unofficial transcripts can be emailed with the application in addition to the official delivered separately. Official transcripts should be mailed directly from the school to address on this application.

- d) Other considerations (Optional): List or describe any other information pertinent to your application for the Committee to review.
